maua (Xylosma hawaiiense)

FLACOURTIACEAE, flacourtia family



This species is endemic to Kaua'i, O'ahu, Moloka'i, Lāna'i, Maui, and Hawai'i island (Wagner <u>et al.</u> 1990). Another Hawaiian name for this species used on Maui is *a'e* (Pukui and Elbert 1986).

<u>Summary statement of uses</u>: No references of ethnobotanical uses for this species have been found.

<u>Status at Auwahi</u>: Just as with $m\bar{a}mane$, this species is present at lower Auwahi but becomes prominent in upper elevation Auwahi (above 3500 feet elevation) where large trees to 40 feet high are a relatively common and characteristic species of this forest.
